

**~ MTGM Saturday, October, 15th Workshop - All Levels, Traditional Wire Jewelry ~
Wire with Cougar - Bracelet & Pendant!**

Day begins at 9:00am and ends around 4:30pm, including lunch and 'stress' breaks as needed. (Please either bring your lunch and beverages or come prepared to get your own "take-out" during lunch break.)

The total cost for a Center member is \$75 (\$15 class fee + \$10 maintenance + \$50 instructor fee = \$75)

The total cost for a non-Center member is \$90 (\$30 class fee + \$10 maintenance + \$50 instructor fee = \$90)

(This includes written follow-up directions and a gemstone puffed heart)

You may choose to either bring your own supplies, or purchase a (sterling silver wire supply kit from the instructor for \$40.00. Please contact the instructor personally if you will need a materials kit.

Each of these projects contains different techniques that progress into one another, teaching the basics of 'traditional wire jewelry design'. (Please note that the retail value of the projects made in class is equal to the cost of tuition and supplies kit!)

Project 1 ~

Start the day by learning the main techniques/skills necessary, to dive into traditional wire jewelry design, by making a 7-wire bangle bracelet with a hook and eye clasp. (Learn to finish ends without filing!) My favorite class for anyone not familiar with making wraps using square, half-hard wire!!

Project 2 ~

Learn the 'Anything Harness' on a large gemstone, puffed heart that can later be used to make almost 'anything' into a pendant! (Instructor will provide hearts for all students - the price is included in the class fee.)

Required materials/per student:

Wire – 22-gauge, square ½ hard = 8 feet

20-gauge ½ round, ½ hard = 3 inches

18-gauge round dead soft = 10 inches

Students Need To Bring These Required tools:

Jeweler's pliers – NO teeth!!

- round nose, chain nose, FLAT nose, cutters
- foot long RULER and cloth tape measure
- quilter's or 3m painter's tape
- Fine/Ultra fine point Sharpie marker
- polishing cloth or piece of Tee shirt
- cushion style mouse pad/work surface
- pin vise, drill or power screwdriver with keyless chuck (instructor will have extras to share in class)
